

Undergraduate Directors Selection Process

Each chapter may nominate one undergraduate candidate to be considered for appointment to the Board of Directors. Each nominee shall complete a Candidate Application Form and submit same to the Home Office along with two supporting letters submitted by non-collegiate members. Each Chapter Adviser must provide his confidential input (written preferred) on his chapter's nominee and send to the Home Office.

The deadline for individuals to apply is February 1.

RVPs and others may submit nominating applications until March 1.

No candidate should be penalized because he is from the same chapter as an alumnus members of the board.

Geographic representation is desirable. Preference should be given to candidates from chapters that are not on probation, and who have participated in at least one regional or National AGR Program (i.e., Leadership Seminars, Convention, Career Day, etc.).

Noble Rulers, Advisers and RVPs are sent a letter in January with selection process, application form and position description.

The six alumni directors of the National Board of Directors make the final selections weighing heavily on the input from RVPs, Advisers and others. Interviews of top candidates by phone or in person may be conducted at the discretion of the National Board of Directors.
