 - When? By April 31 annually
- 3) Develop a 3-5 year financial projection.
 - Who? Finance Committee
 - When? By April 31 annually

Financial Goal cont.

Action Steps:

- 4) Establish a policy for the develop of a reserve fund.
 - Who? Finance Committee
 - When? By August 31 2003
- 5) Continue an effective enforcement collection policy.
 - Who? EC
 - When? On Going
- 6) To develop a schedule of programs and activities that will provide value for each member.
 - Who? EC
 - When? August 31
- 7) To develop a more effective communication plan with all brothers.
 - Who? EC and Alumni Board
 - When? August 31, 2003

Financial Goal cont.

Action Steps:

- 8) Schedule at least 6 fundraisers a year with the goal of raising \$10,000 some of which are in coordination with alumni.
 - Who? Fundraiser Chair/Alumni Chair
 - When? August 31, 2003
- 9) Establish incentive policies that encourage fiscal soundness.
 - Who? EC
 - When? August 31, 2003
