



Hall of Fame Selection Procedures

Nominee Criteria

1. Be a member in good standing of Alpha Gamma Rho.
2. Agree to personally attend Convention, sit for a color portrait to be hung in Home Office. (If deceased, spouse or close relative will be invited to Convention.)

Hall of Fame Committee Duties

1. Aggressively seek out potential nominees utilizing network of Fraternity leadership and publicity to all Fraternity groups.
2. Review all nomination forms.
3. Select two to four Hall of Fame winners (every two years) submitting those choices to National Board of Directors of Alpha Gamma Rho for their approval. Each committee member will rank in order his top five selections. Chairman will tally results and arrange a conference call if necessary.
4. Assist in gathering inductee materials and creating Hall of Fame award ceremonies at National Convention.

Hall of Fame Selection Guidelines

1. Strive for members who are living and can be true role models for present day members.
2. Strive for balance between fraternity service and service to mankind. Other Halls of Fame recognize respective fields of activity, affiliation or association. **This is the Alpha Gamma Rho Fraternity Hall of Fame.** Nominees should have contributed to Fraternity beyond undergraduate activities. Such contribution can be to local chapter, but hopefully involves regional and national as well. It is not imperative to have held Fraternity offices; contributions to Fraternity can be measured in other ways.
3. Select inductees who most exemplify the spirit and ideals of Alpha Gamma Rho.
